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Explanation of Responses:

(1) Options are exercisable in 25% installments annually commencing the first anniversary of date of grant (except in the event of an "acquisition of a control interest" in Engelhard Corporation). All options expire 10 years after the date of grant. Option may expire earlier under certain circumstances. Options permit the satisfaction of tax withholding obligations arising on the exercise thereof by the withholding of shares of stock acquired by such exercise.
