Also on July 20, 2017, Nico Vandervelpen notified the Board of his intention to resign as a member of the Board, effective July 24, 2017, including from its Compensation Committee. Both Dr. Ollier and Mr. Vandervelpen are resigning to focus on other opportunities and neither decision involved any disagreement with the Company, its management or the Board.
