On March 31, 2016, the reporting person was granted 34,650 restricted stock units, of which 11,550 vested on March 31, 2017, 11,550 vested on March 31, 2018 and 11,550 vested on March 31, 2019. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person not later than 60 days following such vesting dates.

(4) The restricted stock units reported as disposed herein were settled for shares of common stock of Ryerson Holding Corporation.

On March 31, 2017, the reporting person was granted 31,350 restricted stock units, of which 10,450 vested on March 31, 2018 and 10,450 vested on March 31, 2019. The remaining 10,450 unvested restricted stock units will vest on March 31, 2020. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person not later than 60 days following such vesting dates.

On March 31, 2018, the reporting person was granted 33,495 restricted stock units, of which 11,165 vested on March 31, 2019. Of the remaining unvested restricted stock units, 11,165 will vest on March 31, 2020 and 11,165 will vest on March 31, 2021. Vested shares will be delivered to the reporting person not later than 60 days following such vesting dates.
