- (1) Represents sales effected pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the reporting person.
  - Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible at any time at the option of the holder into one share of Class A Common Stock and has no expiration date. In addition, each share of Class B Common Stock will automatically convert into one share of Class A Common
- Stock (a) upon transfer thereof, subject to certain exceptions, (b) upon the date on which the outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock represent less than 10% of the aggregate number of shares of the then outstanding Class A Common Stock and Class B Common Stock, or (c) in the event that holders of at least 66 2/3% of the then outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock elect to convert all shares of Class B Common Stock into shares of Class A Common Stock.
- (3) Represents the number of shares required to be sold by the reporting person to cover tax withholding obligations in connection with the vesting of the RSUs listed in Table II and does not represent a discretionary trade by the reporting person.

- These RSUs vest upon the satisfaction of a service condition and an event condition and have no expiration date. The service condition is satisfied as to 1/5th of the shares on March 15, 2014 and as to an additional 1/60th of the shares for each month of continuous service thereafter. The event condition was satisfied on the closing of the issuer's initial public offering of Class A Common Stock.
- (7) Each RSU represents a contingent right to receive one share of Class A Common Stock when vested.
- (8) These RSUs vest upon the satisfaction of a service condition. The service condition is satisfied as to 20% of the shares on March 15, 2016 and as to an additional 5% of the shares for each 3-month period of continuous service thereafter.
- (9) These RSUs vest upon the satisfaction of a service condition and have no expiration date. The service condition is satisfied as to 1/5th of the shares on September 15, 2016 and as to an additional 1/20th of the shares for every three months of continuous service thereafter.
- (10) These RSUs vest upon the satisfaction of a service condition and have no expiration date. The service condition is satisfied as to 1/5th of the shares on March 15, 2017 and as to an additional 1/20th of the shares for every three months of continuous service thereafter.
