**Item 7.01 Regulation FD Disclosure.**

On March 25, 2015, Schlumberger Limited ( Schlumberger ) resolved a previously disclosed investigation by the U.S. Department of Justice into past violations of U.S. sanctions regarding its historical operations in Iran and Sudan that occurred between 2004 and 2010. A non-U.S. subsidiary of Schlumberger has agreed to plead guilty to one criminal count of conspiracy to violate the International Emergency Economic Powers Act. Under the terms of the plea agreement, Schlumberger will pay a total amount of approximately \$232,708,000 in fines, penalties and assessments, a sum that had been previously accrued. All terms of the plea agreement are subject to judicial approval.
