- BCI is also the administrative member of Bain Capital Integral Investors, LLC ("Integral"). On January 16, 2015, Integral sold 5,969,145 **(2)** shares of Common Stock. Following such sale, Integral held 6,373,627 shares of Common Stock.
- BCI is also the administrative member of BCIP TCV, LLC ("BCIP TCV"). On January 16, 2015, BCIP TCV sold 148,136 shares of (3)Common Stock. Following such sale, BCIP TCV held 148,020 shares of Common Stock.
- BCI is also the managing partner of BCIP Associates-G ("BCIP G" and together with Fund IX, Integral and BCIP TCV, the "Bain (4) Entities"). On January 16, 2015, BCIP G sold 2,958 shares of Common Stock. Following such sale, BCIP G held 2,955 shares of Common Stock.
