SkyTerra Communications, Inc. (the "Company") is unable to file its Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2005 without unreasonable effort or expense due to delays caused by unanticipated effects arising from the recent spin-off transaction (the "Transaction") of Hughes Communications, Inc. ("Hughes").

In connection with the Transaction, on December 31, 2005, the Company contributed to Hughes substantially all of the assets and liabilities of the Company other than its interests in each of Mobile Satellite Ventures LP and TerreStar Networks, Inc. and certain designated cash. On February 21, 2006, the Company made a special dividend distribution of all of the outstanding Hughes common stock to the Company's stockholders. As a result of the Transaction, Hughes became an independent, publicly-owned company and the accounting successor to the Company.

The Company intends to file, by March 31, 2006, its Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2005.
